Please be advised that the Williston Police Department has been requested to start strictly enforcing the SC State laws pertaining to golf carts. Here is a copy of the law as written;

Section code 56-3-115

The owner of a vehicle commonly known as a golf cart, if he/she has a valid driver's license, may obtain a permit from the department upon the payment of a fee of five dollars and proof of financial responsibility which permits his agent, employees, or him/her to:

- (1) Operate the golf cart on a secondary highway or street within two miles of his residence or place of business during daylight hours only; and
- (2) Cross a primary highway or street traveling along a secondary highway or within two miles of his residence or place of business during daylight hours only.

In layman's terms a golf cart is required to be registered at the highway department which requires the golf cart to be insured in case of an accident; the registration sticker should be clearly visible to be seen by Law Enforcement, and insurance papers should be kept readily available to be given to police upon request. In town a golf cart may safely cross hwy 78 and hwy 39 but not drive down either hwy.
