**\$5,066,288.00**

The awarded project is for both water system and sewerage system improvements. The SCIIP funds will supplement current CDBG and RIA grant projects for a filtration system and replacement of water lines. These funds are also allocated for improvements at the wastewater treatment facility including replacement of equipment at the head works and treatment pond liners.

**Town Code Enforcement**

**Ordinance Section 14-33**

**An Ordinance about Dogs on a Leash.**



**(A)** All dog, shall be kept under restraints at all times by their owners, while within the town and off the owner’s premises. The owner of a dog, when taking it off the owner’s premises must restrain the dog by placing it in a secure in closure or by securely restraining it on a leash under the physical control of the owner. A dog transporting in a vehicle, including the back of a pickup truck, must not be allowed to exit the vehicle off the owner’s property without being placed under the physical control of the owner on a leash or in a secure enclosure. It shall be unlawful for the owner to fail to so restrain as required by this section shall be deemed to be an animal at large.

**(B)** dogs that are participating in or training for hunting obedience trials, confirmation shows tracking test, herding trials, terrier trials, or lure courses under the direct control of their owner shall not be considered animals at large and are exempt from the requirements of section (a)of the section.

**(C)** any owner whose dog is found at large within the Town shell forfeit, all right, title interest in ownership of the dog subject to the procedures in this chapter
